Ph.D. - First Year

Note: Prior to first day of class, students must contact their Academic/Dissertation Supervisor, plan their program of study, and enroll in required courses.

Fall Semester

Coursework

- Consider writing papers for courses that could lead to publication and possibly a Dissertation topic Dissertation and Supervision
 - Formulate ideas and short-list potential topics for Dissertation research
 - Collaborate with faculty on research projects
